Specialized Coatings Team Demonstrates Expertise with Painted Trucks

Johnstown, PA, March 19, 2026 – Enterprise Ventures Corporation (EVC) recently completed a unique project that showcases its capabilities in specialized coatings.

The team painted two Ford trucks provided by the Ground Vehicle Systems Center (GVSC) to demonstrate the application of our advanced Talon® Coating System (CARC-E and CARC-L). This project highlights EVC’s commitment to innovation, teamwork, and delivering solutions that enhance military survivability.

“This project was a first for our team, painting commercial vehicles with a more intricate CARC-E, CARC-L, and signature management tire coating pattern than ever previously applied to combat vehicles. It’s a testament to our team’s communication, expertise, and commitment to delivering professional results for our clients,” said Leanne Debias, EVC Coatings Product Manager.

GVSC received the trucks from Ford for testing and evaluation purposes, including sensor evaluations during field trials. EVC’s coatings team applied a specialized camouflage pattern using Talon paints, which are designed to reduce the thermal signature of vehicles and provide superior survivability in combat environments.

To accommodate the size of the trucks, EVC purchased a temporary inflatable paint booth, expanding our capabilities to handle larger articles in the future. This project also marked the first time our team used stencils to create intricate patterns on vehicles, overcoming challenges to ensure the stencils were sturdy and the coatings were applied evenly.

The project was a collaborative effort involving most of the coatings team. They demonstrated EVC’s ability to apply three different paints to a vehicle, creating a seamless camouflage pattern that appears as one color to the naked eye but significantly reduces the thermal signature when viewed with infrared sensors. These coatings provide a "hide in plain sight" advantage, increasing asset survivability and giving warfighters a critical edge.
